## ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES 1 – 8 NEED:

- \* scissors (round tipped for primary)    \*phys.ed clothing (not primary)    \*glue sticks (1 per term)
- \*extra change of clothes    \*pencil crayons    \*indoor/outdoor running shoes (non-marking soles please)

## PRIMARY (GRADES 1-3)

- \*plastic metric rulers – cm/mm – not metal or flexible please    \*gr.1 crayons crayons (not fat)
- \*gr.2/3 pencil crayons    \*No binders please, due to limited space in desks

## JUNIOR (GRADES 4-6)

- \*graph paper (1cm)    \*lined paper    \*duotangs (6)    \*2 highlighters    \*calculator
- \*math set    \*3, 1 inch binder (soft poly)    \*pens – blue/red    \*plastic metric rulers – cm/mm

## INTERMEDIATE (GRADES 7-8)

- \*pens – blue/red    \*math set    \*calculator    \*hi-liters    \*duotangs (6)    \*3, 1 inch binders
- \*lined paper (3 ring)    \*graph paper (1cm or ½ cm x ½ cm square)    \*plastic metric rulers – cm/mm
