

Ash Wednesday and Lent Offering

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024 and invites us to make our hearts ready for remembering Jesus' passion and celebrating Jesus' resurrection. Although a solemn time, it is also a hopeful, expectant time of prayer and fasting before acknowledging and celebrating Jesus' death and then His subsequent resurrection on Easter. This year our school, along with fellow BHNCDSB schools will be participating in the Lent Campaign. The purpose of this campaign is to support our St. Vincent de Paul Society to help meet the needs of our neighbours in need in Haldimand County.
